# International Seminar

## The Protection of Biodiversity: Prospects and Challenges

Swiss-Belhotel, Jambi, Indonesia, October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2016



It has been well understood that biodiversity is one of the main pillars sustaining the existence of entire lives including for human beings. Biodiversity boosts ecosystem productivity where each species, no matter how small, all have an important role to play. For example, a large number of species means a greater variety of crops: greater species diversity ensures natural sustainability for all life forms; and healthy ecosystems can better withstand and recover from a variety of disaster. However, it has been long feared that human activities, such as illegal logging and forest burning, are causing massive extinctions of biodiversity.

A promising action happened when in 1992 Canada took a leadership role and being the first industrialized country to sign the international Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD). The CBD committed Canada and 167 other signatories to promote the conservation of biodiversity through domestic initiatives, including the adoption of laws for the protection and recovery of species threatened with extinction. In April 2002, the Parties to the Convention committed to significantly reduce the loss of biodiversity by 2010. Yet predictably that did not happen. Despite numerous successful conservation measures supporting biodiversity, the 2010 biodiversity target had not met at the global level. Therefore, in 2013, as a supplementary agreement of the CBD, the Nagoya Protocol was adopted to ensure the fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising from the utilization of genetic resources, thereby contributing to the conservation and sustainability use of biodiversity. Participating in the protection of biodiversity, Indonesia has ratified both the CBD and the Nagoya Protocol in such statutes as the Law Number 5 Year 1994 and the Law Number 11 Year 2013 respectively.

As the global issue, the protection of biodiversity has to be addressed in many perspectives. Therefore, the Faculty of Law Universitas Jambi is initiating and hosting an International Seminar 'The Protection of Biodiversity: Prospects and Challenges.' The seminar will formulate any suggestions to make the ideals of the CBD and the Nagoya Protocol as well as of any attempts of conserving biodiversity realize not only for the Users but also for Providers, Indigenous People, Local Government, Law Officers, and the State in general. The seminar will further be a forum for interdisciplinary experts representing countries such as Australia, Netherlands, and Indonesia to discuss, share knowledge, and enrich one another on the subject. The seminar will also bring together academicians, practitioners, government officials, environment activists and observers, and scientists to meet together, exchange ideas, and discuss emerging and critical issues on the matter.
